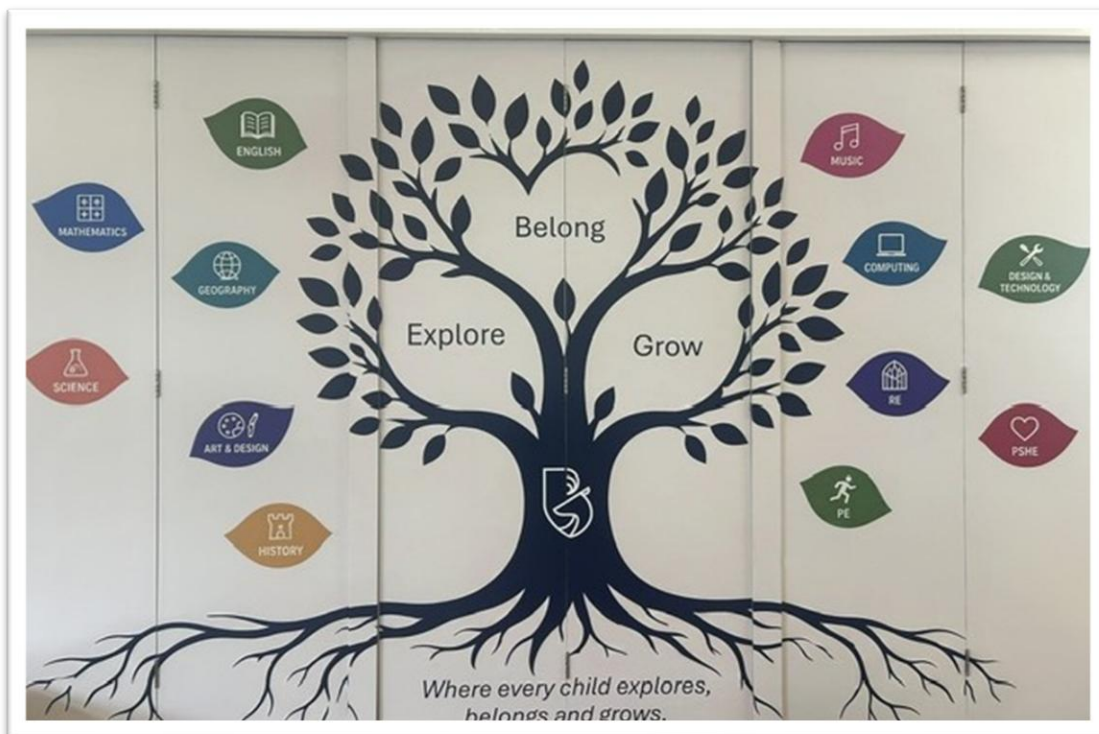
Bike it Hampshire
