



Hiltingbury Infant School is working with sustainable transport charity Sustrans to help reduce traffic congestion and pollution around the school by encouraging as many pupils as possible to walk, scoot, wheel or cycle to school instead of coming in a car.

As part of this, we are participating in the '**Leg it to Lapland**' challenge, in which we are competing against other local schools. This will run from **Monday 9th to Friday 20th December**. All pupils who travel to school actively (journeys made on foot or non-motorised wheels) during the 2 week challenge will clock up virtual miles on our 1385 mile journey from Hampshire to Lapland.

The winning school will be the one with the highest average proportion of active journeys (made on foot or non-motorised wheels) per pupil. This school will win a scooter stunt display to be held at the school and scooter sessions for up to 100 children.

Please help us to win by making a special effort to walk your children to school or allow them to cycle or scoot. If you have to drive but still want to take part, park at least 5 minutes away from the school and walk, cycle or scoot the rest of the way or drop off your child with a friend who walks to school and let them walk in together?
