### YEAR 1 VISIT TO SEA CITY MUSEUM, SOUTHAMPTON

To enhance the curriculum, we arrange activities linked to learning in school. This half term as part of their topic work *Titanic*, Year 1 have arranged for all the children to visit Sea City Museum in Southampton. Chestnut Class and half of Beech Class will be going on Monday, 17<sup>th</sup> and Hazel Class and half of Beech Class will be going Tuesday, 18<sup>th</sup> March. Your child will be going on **Monday, 17<sup>th</sup> March**. They will leave school at 9.15am and return by 3.00pm travelling by coach.

We are able to offer children a free school packed lunch. This will be either a cheese roll/wrap (vegetarian option) or ham roll/wrap (meat option) – both to include a biscuit and a piece of fruit. Otherwise, please provide your child with a packed lunch and a drink. Please could your child also bring a water bottle. If you wish to request a school packed lunch please complete the form by clicking <https://forms.office.com/e/cw53DhH63V> and choose the relevant option **by 5<sup>th</sup> March**, at the latest.

On this occasion the children should wear casual clothes **but please could they wear their school sweatshirt**, sensible shoes and bring a coat. Please ensure that everything is named e.g. jumpers, coats, rucksacks etc.

The cost of the visit is £20.20, which is the cost of the transport (£11.60 per child) and entrance fee to the Museum (£8.60 per child), which includes two workshops and a discovery session. Payment should be made via your Arbor account and no cash will be accepted. Educational visits rely on parents making a voluntary contribution to cover the cost and should there be insufficient contributions the visit may have to be cancelled and money refunded.

If any parent/carer is able to help on this visit, please speak directly to your child's class teacher as soon as possible. We would welcome as many male role models as possible due to a lack of these within our staff community. (You will not need to be DBS checked to help on this visit). Thank you.
