I sent the following email to all parents and carers whose children are in our Resourced Provision this week, but wanted to let the wider community know about what is happening with the Resourced Provision. Please see the update below.

I am writing to make you aware that we are no longer admitting pupils to our Speech and Language Resource Provision, this has been a decision made with Hampshire County Council as they explore the best way to meet the needs of local children going forward.

I have always been extremely proud of our Resourced Provision and of the dedicated and knowledgeable Speech and Language staff, many of whom have worked for the school for many years. Understandably this period of transition and change has meant that some staff have secured opportunities elsewhere and this summer we will say goodbye to Mrs Scarr, Ms Wallace, Mrs Rimmer and Mrs Howe. They will be greatly missed and we wish them well in their new endeavours.
