### YEAR 1 VISIT TO MANOR FARM

To enhance the children's history learning, we arrange activities linked to learning in school. Next half term Year 1 have arranged for all the children to visit Manor Farm on **Monday, 1<sup>st</sup> June**. They will leave school at 9.15am and return by 3.00pm travelling by coach.

We are able to offer children a free school packed lunch. This will be either a cheese sandwich (vegetarian option) or ham sandwich (meat option) – both to include a biscuit and a piece of fruit. Please note you will need to provide a water bottle as the school packed lunch does not include a drink. Otherwise, please provide your child with a packed lunch and a drink. If you wish to request a school packed lunch please complete the form by clicking [Fill in form](#) and choose the relevant option by **14<sup>th</sup> May**, at the latest.

The children should wear their school polo shirt and school jumper with comfortable, appropriate trousers/leggings/shorts and sensible shoes and bring a sunhat or raincoat, depending on the weather. Please also ensure your child has sun cream on before they come to school and that everything is named e.g. jumpers, coats.

The cost of the visit is £22.30, which is the cost of the transport (£12.80 per child) and entrance fee to Manor Farm (£9.50 per child), which includes activities during the day. Payment should be made via your Arbor account and no cash will be accepted. Educational visits rely on parents making a voluntary contribution to cover the cost and should there be insufficient contributions the visit may have to be cancelled and money refunded.

If any parent/carer is able to help on this visit, please speak directly to your child's class teacher as soon as possible. We would welcome as many male role models as possible due to a lack of these within our staff community. (You will not need to be DBS checked to help on this visit). Thank you.
