Sports Day 2026 - Monday 15th June

We are very much looking forward to welcoming you to this year's Sports Day! This year, children will take part in a series of multi-skills activities followed by races. Each year group's events have been timetabled together for your convenience:

Year R: 9:10 - 10:25 am

Year 1: 10:30 - 11:45 am

Year 2: 1:30 - 2:40 pm

Please ensure your child comes to school dressed in their PE kit, including a t-shirt in their team colour and suitable footwear (e.g. trainers).

Team Colours

Children should wear a t-shirt in their team colour:

Holly, Beech, and Apple Classes - **RED**

Spruce, Hazel, and Cherry Classes - **BLUE**

Cedar, Chestnut, and Plum Classes - **WHITE**

Each session will begin with multi-skills activities, which children will rotate through in their classes. Families are invited to watch and cheer from the central cordoned-off area. This will be followed by individual races, during which we ask spectators to move to the opposite side of the track from the classes and remain there for the duration. After the races, children will return to class with their teachers.

- Please enter and exit the school via Gate 4 (on the field).
- Children will need a clearly named water bottle, and if the weather is sunny, please ensure they have a hat and that sunscreen is applied before school.
- A reminder that the school grounds are a non-smoking site, including e-cigarettes, and dogs are not permitted anywhere on site.
