Allbrook Hill Roadworks

Current update from Hampshire County Council regarding the project to provide improved pedestrian facilities around the junction of Allbrook Hill and Twyford Road. The works started on Monday 20 April for a planned duration of approximately six weeks. There have been some delays with construction activities on site and as a result the project has taken longer to complete than originally planned. The final stages of works are as follows:

- The ongoing works within the verge area at Allbrook Hill/Twyford Road (around the service road) will continue during daytime periods and are expected to be completed this week.
- From 22 June there will be up to one week of night-time closures to complete the works around the new crossing point and central island on Twyford Road (immediately south of the roundabout).

Permitted working hours for night-works are Monday to Friday between 7:00pm and 6:00am. Night-time road closures are necessary to safely complete the works and minimise traffic

disruption in the wider area. The works will generate some construction noise however we will seek to reasonably minimise disturbance and complete the noisiest activities by 11pm each night. Pedestrian access along Twyford Road and Allbrook Hill will remain available throughout the works. Emergency vehicle access to properties will be maintained at all times during the closures. Advance warning signs will be in place.
