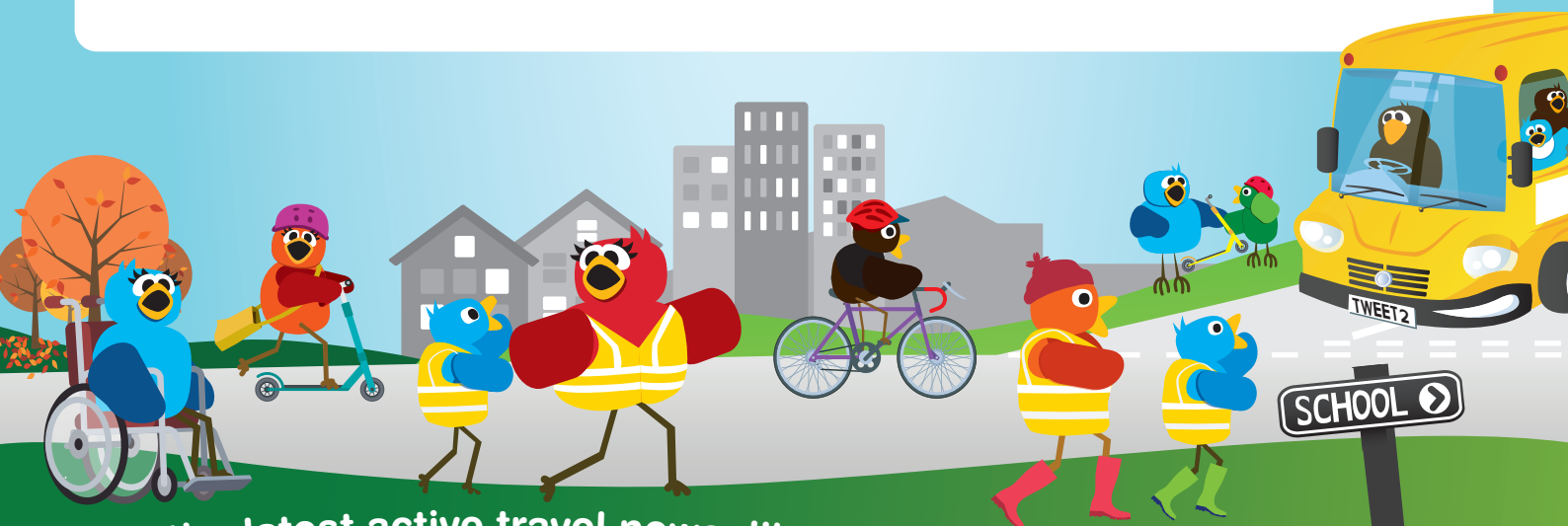
Stepping up for: our planet, our wellbeing and our community
