

Core Daily - Please continue to read with your child everyday talking about the pictures, characters and what happens in the text. Practise all the sounds and tricky words we have learnt so far (see home learning resource pack for these). Please see website for phonics and cued articulation videos to practise all the sounds.

Phonics/ Reading	Watch the 'Phonics Recap' video on tapestry. Can you use your sound cards to practise all the sounds we have learnt? Can you use these to make some words? Writing	Rainbow Writing Use 3 different colours to write your name in the cursive style like we have practised in school. Make sure you are starting with a lead in and finishing with a lead out	Listen to the story 'One snowy Night..' on tapestry. Can you write a list of words or draw some pictures that make you think of winter, eg. Cold, icy, frost etc. In the winter I see...
Maths	Choose a number 1 – 10. How many different ways can you represent that number in your house? (e.g. find it on clock, count out 8 cheerios, make a tower of 8 cubes, do 8 jumps etc)	Watch Mrs Jupe on tapestry singing some counting songs. Learning tasks across the week – pick 1 or more from each section

Understanding of the World	Go on a scavenger hunt in the house/ garden and find objects that are man made/ natural. Can you sort them?	Talk about the seasons. What season are we in now? Can you draw pictures of what we do in each season?
Expressive Arts and Design	Paint a picture of your choice using cold colours, eg. pale blues, greys, greens	Find any recyclable objects and create your own junk model.
Physical Development	Can you run fast/ slow for 10 seconds? Have a go at jumping/ skipping / side stepping.	Practise your throwing and catching in the garden or on a walk. What happens if you use a smaller ball? Is it easier or harder?
Personal Social and Emotional Development	Find something in your house that makes you happy and tell a grown up why it makes you happy. Draw a picture of it if you like.	Play some board games with family members. Ask them to read some of the instructions and follow them while you are playing. Ensure you take turns.
