Dear Parents & Carers,

Welcome back to all our families with children in Years 1 & 2 and a very big welcome to all our new Year R families. It has been wonderful having all the children back and seeing them settle so well into their new classes. The children and staff have coped very well with this very hot September weather! Mrs Flood and I have enjoyed getting round the classrooms, engaging with the children and spending time with them at playtime and lunchtime. All classes have had a strong focus on building positive relationships and getting to know one another well in this first week as we know this is so important to establish early on. My assembly to Years 1 and 2 on Tuesday was a welcome back and reminder of our three school rules 'Be Safe, Be Kind, Be Ready' which they have remembered really well. We also talked lots about staying safe in the sun with the very hot weather this week!

### **Learning Highlights from Each Year Group**

### Year R

It has been wonderful to visit all of our new families this week; we are really looking forward to working together to ensure a smooth transition into school. It was great to find out about the children, see their favourite toys and even meet some of their pets! All the children looked very smart in their new uniforms on their first day at school today and we were delighted to be greeted by so many excited children, eager to come into their classrooms. We have enjoyed getting to know the children this week, introducing them to their new classrooms and having lots of fun playing!

### Year 1

The Year 1 children have settled well back into school and are learning the new routines for Year 1. The Year 1 teachers are particularly proud in the way in which they have returned to school especially when leaving their parents at the door. During the week the children have worked hard to listen and follow instructions in areas of the curriculum and they have enjoyed learning to work in teams. Each class have enjoyed playing parachute games, having circle times, continuing their learning in phonics and reading.
